MHRI County Fair Racing Conditions

MHRI races under the rules and regulations of the United States Trotting Association. In addition, the following conditions and policies will govern races at MHRI sponsored meets.

- Entry fees: \$40.00.
Horses may only enter one race at each fair.
- Proof of negative Coggins test within one (1) year is required at all race meets.
- Per Rule 13, Section 13.05 of the USTA rules: in overnight events, if there are less than five (5) starters, the premium for the positions for which there are no starters may be retained by the Association.
- **MN Owned is defined as a horse of which at least a 50% interest is owned by a MN resident. Residency is defined per MN Department of Revenue status.**
- In the event of a rainout, money may be carried over to the next year at the discretion of MHRI.
- Races may be charted at all MHRI sponsored meets in Minnesota as per majority of horseperson's entered.
- We reserve the right to split according to the entries received and track conditions.
- Maximum number of starters per race:

Cannon Falls Score 5, Start 8
- MHRI provides race day accident insurance for all drivers at MHRI sponsored race meets.





MHRI County Fair Racing Conditions (Continued)

- An owner or part owner may not have more than two (2) horses in each MN Bred race.
- All owners, trainers and drivers must have liability insurance which is provided through membership in the MHRI for 2020. Those who are not members will be allowed to join on race day.
- Drug testing on horses can be conducted at all MHRI sponsored meets at any time, pre and post-race. Levels for approved medications will be at the same levels allowed and tested for at Running Aces.
- Breathalyzer testing may be conducted at all MHRI meets. The following individuals may be tested: drivers, anyone warming up a horse, and appointed officials.
- The following point system is used for year-end awards for horses and drivers for the MHRI sponsored race meets:

1 st Place	50 Points
2 nd Place	25 Points
3 rd Place	12 Points
4 th Place	08 Points
5 th Place	05 Points

Event #3 goes for \$5,000 - \$3,000 if 2 divisions and \$8,000 if 1 division.

Event #4 goes for \$5,000 - \$3,000 if 2 divisions and \$8,000 if 1 division.

If events #1 and #3 go 3 divisions, MHRI will add \$2,000 for the C Class.

Races 1 thru 6 will be divided ABC by lifetime earnings.

FFA's split into divisions per USTA rules.

\$8,000 in purses will be distributed for event #'s 5,6,7, and 8. Other scenarios will be determined by the MHRI board of directors as needed at time of entry.

Event #1 goes for \$5,000 - \$3,000 if 2 divisions and \$8,000 if 1 division.

Event #2 goes for \$5,000 - \$3,000 if 2 divisions and \$8,000 if 1 division.

Event #3 goes for \$5,000 - \$3,000 if 2 divisions and \$8,000 if 1 division.

Event #4 goes for \$5,000 - \$3,000 if 2 divisions and \$8,000 if 1 division.

If events #1 and #3 go 3 divisions, MHRI will add \$2,000 for the C Class.

Races 1 thru 6 will be divided ABC by lifetime earnings.

FFA's split into divisions per USTA rules.

\$8,000 in purses will be distributed for event #'s 5,6,7, and 8. Other scenarios will be determined by the MHRI board of directors as needed at time of entry.



Minnesota Bred Races at Running Aces

There are 6 races scheduled for 2YO pacers, and 6 races for 2YO trotters, which will be conducted on Tuesday beginning on July 14th, 2020, in addition to the Finals which will be conducted on Minnesota Night of Champions.

There are 10 races scheduled for 3YO pacers, and 10 races for 3YO trotters, which will be conducted on Saturday and Sunday beginning on June 27th/28th 2020, respectively, in addition to the Finals which will be conducted on Minnesota Night of Champions.

Each scheduled race for 2YO and 3YO MN Breds will have an estimated total purse of between \$15,000 and \$23,000.

2YO & 3YO races will be split if possible, first by sex to create full and balanced fields.

If enough horses are not entered to separate by sex, horses will then be divided by lifetime earnings (2YO's) and earnings in last 4 starts (3YO's) to create full and balanced fields.

If the scheduled race goes ONE division, it will go for the entire purse of \$15,000.

If the scheduled race goes TWO divisions and is split by sex, \$8,000 will be added to the base purse of \$15,000 and each division will go for 50% of the advertised purse or \$11,500.

If the scheduled race goes TWO divisions, split by earnings, the A division will go for 60% and the B division will go for 40% of the advertised purse of \$23,000.

(A = \$13,800 and B = \$9,200)

If the scheduled race is divided into 3 divisions, split by earnings, the divisions will go for \$23,000; split 50%, 30% and 20% or TBA.



Minnesota Bred Races at Running Aces

If the scheduled race is split into 3 divisions, with 2 of the divisions of one sex split by earnings and a 3rd division of the other sex, then the \$23,000 purse will be split 37.5%, 37.5% and 25% or TBA.

If 2YO races are split by earnings, it will be based on LIFETIME EARNINGS. If 3YO races are split by earnings, it will be based on earnings in their LAST 4 STARTS.

In any case, no uneven fields should be carded and either a division by sex or earnings should be used to create balanced fields if possible. Any other division scenarios will be dealt with by the Race Secretary and after consultation with the MHRI officers.

If a class does not fill with 6 separate betting interests, the race secretary, after consultation with MHRI officers, may card the race as a non-betting race. If there are 3, 4, or 5 separate betting interests, the race will go as a non-betting race for a reduced purse. If only 1-2 horses entered, the money will roll over to future MN Bred races.

In order to make competitive races, if a horse wins 2 MN Bred races in the A division (or by sex) in a row or wins 3 out of their last 4 starts in MN Bred races, that horse will be assigned to the outside post. Winning in the class B & C division then moving to class A, you should not be assigned an outside position. Other scenarios that continue to produce negative betting pools may also be addressed after consultation with the MHRI officers.



Minnesota Bred Races at Running Aces

If a cancellation of a MN Bred race occurs due to factors beyond our control, for example, technical issues, power outage, weather related, etc., those MN Bred races will be rewritten on the days that the open 2YO and 3YO races were scheduled.

MN Bred horses will receive an extra win in non-restricted, non-winner classes.

MN Bred horses will receive an extra 30% in money earnings in non-restricted conditioned races.

MN Bred horses will receive a 50% allowance in claiming races.

MN Bred horses will receive preference if tied with a horse which is not MN Bred.

MN Bred horses that finish 1-2-3 in a non-restricted race at Running Aces will receive a 25% bonus on those earnings.



2020 Minnesota Night of Champions Conditions

2020 Minnesota Night of Champions is Saturday, October 3rd, 2020. First Post is at 1:00 pm.

Fields will be limited to the top ten (10) money earners at Running Aces. For 2- and 3-year old's, that money must be earned in the 2 and 3-year-old MN Bred restricted, featured races in 2020, per the schedule of weekly races included in this booklet. Additional MN Bred horses that earned purse money at Running Aces may be eligible to enter if additional separate betting interests are needed, and if so, will draw outside posts of regular qualifying horses. No owner may start more than two (2) entrants in any given race. Ties for a final spot will be broken by lot.

Two-year old's must make at least 2 money starts at Running Aces in 2020 to be eligible, or 50% of their money starts in 2020 must be at Running Aces, all in the MN Bred 2YO featured races.

Three-year old's must make at least 5 money starts at Running Aces in 2020 to be eligible, or 50% of their money starts in 2020 must be at Running Aces, all in the MN Bred 3YO featured races.

A minimum of six (6) separate betting interests are required for a race to fill. If an event does not fill, the Race Secretary, after consultation with MHRI officers, may choose to schedule the races as a non-betting race for the Purse Supplement from the Breeders Fund, as approved by the MRC, and from funds per an agreement between MHRI and Running Aces. If an event does not fill, the gender of each class may be combined with the total purse being up to \$45,000.

There is no entry or starting fee required at the time of entry into the finals. A horse must be eligible to start in a race within the current qualifying standards at Running Aces and the MRC for all race horses with official track variances allowed. Qualifying races will be available the Tuesday before the Night of Champions if necessary.
