


How to Read a Chart (results)



1	Race info	Race #, Track, State and date	14	1/2	The position and how far back from the leader each horse was at the half pole
2	Condition	Horses must meet this condition to compete in this race	15	3/4	The position and how far back from the leader each horse was at the three-quarter pole
3	Gait	Pace or Trot	16	Str (Stretch)	The position and how far back from the leader each horse was down the stretch
4	Purse	The total amount of money horses are racing for, usually divided among the top five finishers in a race.	17	Finish	The position each horse finished in
5	Class	The level of competition at which a horse competes	18	Actual	The final time each horse finished the race
6	Distance	Length of the race	19	LQ (Last Quarter)	How fast each horse raced in the last quarter
7	Track Condition	FT = Fast GD = Good MY = Muddy SL = Slow SY = Sloppy	20	Odds	The betting odds for each horse when the race went off
8	Temp – Allow	Air Temperature – Time allowance if the track is not fast	21	Driver	The person who drove each horse during the race
9	Off-Time	What time the race started	22	Trainer	The trainer for each horse
10	HN (Head Number)	The horse's number – usually corresponds to the pole position	23	Time	The time the lead horse reached each quarter of the track. The number in () indicates how fast that quarter was.
11	Horse	The horses competing in the race	24	The top 3 finishers	The top 3 finishers in the race and what they paid out to bettors
12	PP (Post Position)	The order in which the horses were lined up behind the starting gate	25	Exotic bet payouts	Payouts for exotic bets
13	1/4	The position and how far back from the leader each horse was at the quarter pole	26	Winner information	Age, sex, pedigree, owner(s), and breeder(s) of the winning horse
