MHRI Membership

We encourage all horsemen, racing in the state of Minnesota, at Running Aces and in MHRI sponsored Fairs, to become members. See the MHRI website at mnharness.com for an application or use the one included in this booklet.

Benefits of Membership:

- **COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY** – Harness Horsemen International's \$4,000 scholarship is available to children of a member of an HHI member association. (Must complete an application to apply)
- **ELIGIBILITY** – to run for the MHRI Board of Directors
- **INVOLVEMENT** – on MHRI committees
- **LIMITED FIRE AND DISASTER INSURANCE** – for an eligible member-owned Standardbred horse while at scheduled racetracks, training centers or fairgrounds, of up to \$15,000 for a horse which is racing, up to \$5,000 for a horse in training, and up to \$3,000 per horse for tack (with a maximum of \$10,000 tack coverage for any one owner).
- **PARTICIPATION** – in MHRI Fair races
- **REPRESENTATION** – with elected officials, regulatory agencies in Minnesota, Minnesota Racing Commission and Running Aces
- **SULKY/JOG CART INSURANCE** – provides coverage of up to \$1,750 for a damaged sulky/jog cart (see policy for details)
- **THIRD PARTY LIABILITY INSURANCE** – provides liability coverage for owners of a standardbred horse that causes bodily injury or property damage. Policy provides \$1,000,000 dollar occurrence/\$5,000,000 aggregate.
- **VOTING PRIVILEGES** – for annual MHRI Board of Directors

Highlight of changes made in 2024

- MN Bred horses finishing out of the money in a MN Bred Restricted race at Running Aces will not receive a stipend, as in years past.
- Purses for Pre-Meet Cannon Falls Fairs, changed to \$1,000.
- All 2YOs (Pacers & Trotters) races will be held on Tuesdays at Running Aces.
- In MN Bred Races at Running Aces, if only 1-2 horses are entered, each horse will be compensated 37.5% of the posted purse amount.
- To be eligible for the finals/consolations, all horses must have 2 starts or qualifiers in the state of Minnesota during 2024.
- Ties for Night of Champions will be broken by the horse with the most starts in Minnesota, then broken by lot.
- Mid-season MN Bred Aged races removed.
- Champions for 2YO and 3YO divisions will be decided by the top money earners in MN Bred Restricted races at Running Aces, as listed in this booklet. Aged division champions will be decided by the top money earners in all races at Running Aces, as listed in this booklet. Money earned includes Night of Champions but does not include Fairs.



MHRI Fair Racing Conditions

MHRI races under the rules and regulations of the United States Trotting Association. In addition, the following conditions and policies will govern races at MHRI sponsored meets.

- Entry fees: \$40.00.
Horses may only enter one race at each fair.
- Proof of negative Coggins test within 1 year is required at all race meets.
- Per Rule 13, Section 13.05 of the USTA rules: in overnight events, if there are less than 5 starters, the premium for the positions for which there are no starters may be retained by the Association.
- **MN Owned is defined as a horse of which at least a 50% interest is owned by a MN resident. Residency is defined per MN Department of Revenue status.**
- In the event of a rainout, money may be carried over to the next year at the discretion of MHRI.
- Races may be charted at all MHRI sponsored meets in Minnesota as per majority of horsepersons entered.
- We reserve the right to split according to the entries received and track conditions.
- MHRI provides race day accident insurance for all drivers at MHRI sponsored race meets.
- **All owners, trainers and drivers must be members of MHRI. Those who are not members will be allowed to join on race day.**



MHRI Fair Racing Conditions (Continued)

- Drug testing on horses can be conducted at all MHRI sponsored meets at any time, pre- and post-race. Levels for approved medications will be at the same levels allowed and tested for at Running Aces.
- Breathalyzer testing may be conducted at all MHRI meets. The following individuals may be tested: drivers, anyone warming up a horse, and appointed officials.
- The following point system is used for MHRI sponsored race meets for Fair year-end awards for horses, drivers, and trainers:

1 st Place	50 Points
2 nd Place	25 Points
3 rd Place	12 Points
4 th Place	8 Points
5 th Place	5 Points

Minnesota Bred Races at Running Aces

2 and 3YO schedule

2YO are scheduled for 8 dates for each gait. 3YO are scheduled for 12 dates for each gait. All gaits will also race in the finals conducted on Minnesota Night of Champions.

2YO Trotters	Tuesdays	Beginning June 25
2YO Pacers	Tuesdays	Beginning June 25
3YO Trotters	Sundays	Beginning June 2
3YO Pacers	Thursdays	Beginning May 30

If a cancellation of a MN Bred race occurs due to factors beyond our control, for example, technical issues, power outage, weather related, etc., those MN Bred races will be rewritten on the days that the open 2YO and 3YO races were scheduled.

Creating full and balanced fields for 2 and 3YOs

If possible, races will be split by sex. May race uneven fields to facilitate splitting by sex if the minimum number of starters is met. A minimum of 5 may race after consultation between the Director of Racing and the MHRI.

If enough horses are not entered to separate by sex, horses will be divided into A/B/C divisions:

- 2YOs by lifetime earnings
- 3YOs by earnings last 4 starts

If unable to split divisions equally, the A division should have the lesser number of starters.

If the scheduled race is split into 3 divisions, horses may be split by sex, with 2 divisions of one sex and a 3rd division of the other sex or all 3 divisions will be divided by:

- 2YOs by lifetime earnings
- 3YOs by earnings last 4 starts

In this A/B/C structure, divisions will be split equally OR A will have less than the B, and the B less than the C and so on.

A division by sex or earnings should be used to create balanced fields if possible. Any other division scenarios will be dealt with by the Director of Racing after consultation with the MHRI officers.



If a class does not fill with 6 separate betting interests, the Director of Racing, after consultation with MHRI officers, may card the race as a non-betting race.

If there are 3, 4, or 5 separate betting interests, the race may go as a non-betting race. If only 1-2 horses entered, each horse will be compensated 37.5% of the posted purse amount.

To have competitive races, horses that win 3 out of the last 4 MN Bred races, will be assigned to the outside post. This excludes winners in the B & C divisions moving to class A. Other scenarios that continue to produce negative betting pools may also be addressed after consultation with the MHRI officers.



Purse structure for 2YO and 3YO races will be as follows

Each scheduled race for 2YO and 3YO MN Breds will have an estimated total purse of between \$21,000 to \$55,000.

- **1 Division will race**
 - Will race for a purse of \$21,000.

- **2 Divisions**
 - **Split by sex:** Each division will race for \$17,500.
 - **Split by earnings:** The A division will race for \$21,000 and the B division will race for \$14,000.

- **3 Divisions**
 - **Split by earnings:** Monies will be added to the base purse. The A division will race for \$21,000, the B division for \$14,000, and the C division \$8,500.
 - **Split by earnings and sex:** When there are enough entries to force three divisions, but one sex can race all in one race that sex will race together for \$17,000 with the other sex racing an A division also for \$17,000 and a B division for \$8,500.

Purse levels may be adjusted at the discretion of MHRI and Running Aces.

Incentives for MN Breds

- MN Bred horses will receive an extra win in non-restricted, non-winner classes (excludes maidens).
- MN Bred horses will receive an extra 30% in money earnings in non-restricted conditioned races. Ex. non-winners of \$5,500 (MN \$7,150) in last 4 starts.
- MN Bred horses will receive a 50% allowance in claiming races.
- MN Bred horses will receive preference if tied with a horse which is not MN Bred.
- MN Bred horses that finish 1-2-3 in a non-restricted race at Running Aces will receive a 30% bonus on those earnings.



2024 Minnesota Night of Champions Conditions

2024 Night of Champions is Saturday, September 19 – post time at 6 PM.

Fields for the finals shall be limited to the top 9 money earners of the finals entrants. For 2 & 3 YO's it is money that has been earned in MN Bred Restricted races at Running Aces, as listed in this booklet.

Total money earned at Running Aces for the meet, will determine eligibility for **aged horses**.

To be eligible for the finals/consolations, all horses must have 2 starts or qualifiers in the state of Minnesota during 2024.

A finals race must have six separate betting interests at the time of the draw to be considered filled. If an event does not fill, after consultation between the Director of Racing and MHRI officers, the finals race may be contested as a non-wagering event.

All finals races must be contested.

All earnings will be calculated from May 19, 2024, up to and including September 15, 2024.

Ties are broken by the horse with the most starts in Minnesota, then broken by lot.

All finals shall be contested for the advertised purse.

There shall be no entry or starting fee at the time of entry for the finals. All horses must be eligible to start within current qualifying standards at Running Aces and MRC at the time of entry. Qualifying races shall be held Sunday before the draw for Night of Champions.

- **COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY** – Harness Horsemen International's \$4,000 scholarship is available to children of a member of an HHI member association. (Must complete an application to apply)
- **ELIGIBILITY** – to run for the MHRI Board of Directors
- **INVOLVEMENT** – on MHRI committees
- **LIMITED FIRE AND DISASTER INSURANCE** – for an eligible member-owned Standardbred horse while at scheduled racetracks, training centers or fairgrounds, of up to \$15,000 for a horse which is racing, up to \$5,000 for a horse in training, and up to \$3,000 per horse for tack (with a maximum of \$10,000 tack coverage for any one owner).
- **PARTICIPATION** – in MHRI Fair races
- **REPRESENTATION** – with elected officials, regulatory agencies in Minnesota, Minnesota Racing Commission and Running Aces
- **SULKY/JOG CART INSURANCE** – provides coverage of up to \$1,750 for a damaged sulky/jog cart (see policy for details)
- **THIRD PARTY LIABILITY INSURANCE** – provides liability coverage for owners of a standardbred horse that causes bodily injury or property damage. Policy provides \$1,000,000 dollar occurrence/\$5,000,000 aggregate.
- **VOTING PRIVILEGES** – for annual MHRI Board of Directors
